FERNANDO GONZÁLEZ

"... I simply want to reiterate that at no time did I endanger the national security of the United States, nor was this ever my intent, or that of my comrades."

FERNANDO WAS ORIGINALLY SENTENCED TO 19 YEARS IN PRISON, AND WAS RESENTENCED TO 17 YEARS AND 9 MONTHS AT THE END OF 2009.



RENÉ GONZÁLEZ

"Our trial was converted into a propaganda campaign by the prosecutors, stirring up prejudices against Cuba among the jurors, to achieve a conviction."

RENÉ GONZÁLEZ WAS RELEASED FROM MARIANNA FEDERAL CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION IN FLORIDA, ON OCT. 7, 2011
AFTER SERVING MORE THAN 13 YEARS.
HOWEVER, JUDGE LENARD ORDERED HIM TO SERVE A 3-YEAR PROBATION IN THE UNITED STATES. On May 5, 2013, while René was on a court-approved 2-week trip to Cuba for his father's memorial service, the court finally allowed René to remain in Cuba after renouncing his U.S. citizenship. RENÉ IS

ANTONIO GUERRERO

"... My beloved brothers and I must be unjustly kept in prison, but there we shall not cease from defending the cause and the principles we have embraced."

TONY WAS ORIGINALLY SENTENCED TO LIFE IMPRISONMENT PLUS 10 YEARS, AND WAS RESENTENCED TO 21 YEARS AND 10 MONTHS AT THE END OF 2009.

GERARDO HERNÁNDEZ

"Ours may be one of the most ridiculous accusations of espionage in the history of this country."

HERNÁNDEZ IS SENTENCED TO TWO LIFE TERMS PLUS 15 YEARS AND IS IN U.S.P. VICTORVILLE, CALIFORNIA.
